NOTIFICATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE COUNCIL OF STATE
RE: STANDARDS OF VIRTUE AND ETHICS OF OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES
OF THE OFFICE OF THE COUNCIL OF STATE

Whereas Section 77 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand provides that the State shall prepare the standards of virtue and ethics of government officials and employees, to prevent dishonesty and misconduct, and to enhance efficiency in the performance of duties.

The Office of the Council of State therefore sets the standards of virtue and ethics of its officials and employees as follows:

1. To be a visionary, a self-improver, to be knowledgeable in new technologies, to have the initiative to develop the organisation to be trusted and accepted.
2. To perform duties to the best of one's abilities with honesty and intent, to be courageous in thought, speech, action, and to accept responsibility on the basis of righteousness and fairness.
3. To be compassionate and helpful in the performance of official duties, to have an open mind in listening to the opinions and rationales of others, and to work as a team.
4. To perform work in under their responsibility for the ultimate benefit of the country and the people with equality, transparency, fairness and accountability at all levels, without prejudice and not be under any influence.
5. To be service-minded, to be polite in speech and action, and to coordinate benefits with all parties in the best interest of the country and the people.
6. To create and stimulate a conscience that fosters public responsibility, and to be a role model for others;
7. To maintain dignity of oneself and of the Office, by refraining from any act which may degrade the reputation and image of the Office.
